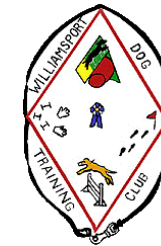

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and that they have the appropriate vaccinations.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- Entries must be submitted on the complete current official AKC Entry form dated 1/1/07, which includes the Agreement page. The payment needs to be made out to the club and for the correct amount.
- Preliminary confirmations will be sent by e/mail as soon as entries are processed. Final confirmations will be e/mailed within 48 hours of the closing date of the trial.
- Revised confirmations will be e/mailed whenever a correction or move-up is received. If you do not receive a revision, your request was not received.
- **IF YOU DO NOT HAVE AN EMAIL ADDRESS**, please provide 2 stamped return envelopes with your entry so that the preliminary and final confirmations can be mailed to you.
- ***Please do not staple or tape your entry form, check and height card together.***

MOVE-UP FORM

As per Section 19, American Kennel Club Regulation for Agility Trials, dogs may be moved up to a higher class, at the request of the Owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title. Dogs so moved up will be entered at the end of the running order or otherwise at the secretary's or Judge's discretion.

E/MAILED MOVE-UPS: When emailing a move-up, please just give the following information. TRIAL NAME, Owner Name, Dog Call Name, Move-up for what days (Saturday, Sunday, etc.), Moving from, Moving to (PLEASE include STD or JWW)

NOVICE MOVE-UPS: Dogs having attained their first AKC Agility Title (Std **OR** JWW) must be moved to the Nov B Class (Std **and** JWW) for all trials that have not reached the closing date. Once a trial closing date has past, a dog cannot be moved from Nov A to Nov B. If the trial has Move ups for Saturday/Sunday are due in writing by the **Monday at 6:00 p.m.** the week of the trial.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. All height divisions will be offered in both the standard classes and the jumpers with weaves classes.

Regular exhibitors may choose to enter their dog in a higher height division than required by AKC, but not in a height division lower than the AKC mandated height. **Preferred** exhibitors are required to jump in their proper height division.

Dogs 11 inches and under at the withers	8 inches	4 inches
Dogs 14 inches and under at the withers	12 inches	8 inches
Dogs 18 inches and under at the withers	16 inches	12 inches
Dogs 22 inches and under at the withers	20 inches	16 inches
Dogs over 22 inches	24 inches	20 inches

Dogs may be entered at 26" height at their owner's discretion.

MEASURING

If you have never been measured for a permanent AKC jump height card, you can still enter any AKC Agility Trial. Your confirmation letter will indicate if there will be an Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO). If so, this person will measure your dog and you will receive a temporary jump height card. All jump heights **MUST** be measured. The AKC will send you permanent jump height card in the mail in a couple of weeks. If you do have a permanent jump height card from the AKC, you must include a photocopy of the card with your entry form.

If there is no official measurer at the trial, you will be measured by the judge for that weekend only. If there isn't a VMO present and your dog jumps 24", you will not need to be measured for the weekend. You will still, however, need to have the dog measured officially at some point.

If your dog measures lower during the weekend, you cannot move your dog down in jump height for that trial. If your dog measures higher than the class you originally entered, you must show your dog in the higher jump height for that weekend and subsequent shows.

****NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS ****

- **OPENING DATE 8:00 a.m. November 10, 2009** at 6719 Old Grange Road, Slatington, PA 18080. Trial is LIMITED to 660 runs per day. **CLOSING DATE** for entries 12:00 pm, **January 5, 2010**, after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules and in Chapter 1, Section 13 of the AKC Agility Trial Rules and Regulations.
- **ENTRY FEE** \$25.00 for the first entry of a dog; \$13.00 for each additional entry of the same dog per day. (Includes a \$3.00 AKC recording fee per run.) Envelopes/transactions cannot have entries for more than the (10) dogs maximum.
- **MAIL ALL ENTRIES WITH FEES PAYABLE TO WDTC, Joanne Stock, 6719 Old Grange Road, Slatington, PA 18080. Express mail deliveries must indicate "no signature required" for delivery.**
- **Entries not submitted on the current official AKC Entry forms (dated 1/1/07) or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules attached to the Official AKC Entry Form are not acceptable. Exhibitors are responsible for errors in making out entry forms.**
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- **REFUND POLICY:** Refunds will be given for bitches in season and for injured dogs. In order to be considered, requests must be received by the Trial Secretary, in writing, by the last day of the trial. All refund requests must be accompanied by a signed, dated letter on official business letterhead from your veterinarian stating the reason that your dog cannot compete. E/emails, telephone calls, and non-letterhead notes will not be considered.
- There will be a \$5.00 processing fee deducted per day from all refunded entry fees. This is per dog.
- Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid by the exhibitor will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. This includes the areas surrounding the outside of the show building.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.
- **JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS.** The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.
- Dogs participating must be fifteen months of age or older and must be registered with the American Kennel Club or have an AKC Limited Registration or ILP or PAL registration. Dogs must be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.
- Dogs may arrive any time prior to Judging, if a copy of their jump height card was sent with their entry. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring at the times specified in the schedule..
