MOVE-UP FORM

As per Section 19, American Kennel Club Regulation for Agility Trials, dogs may be moved up to a higher class, at the request of the Owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title. Dogs so moved up will be entered at the end of the running order or otherwise at the secretary's or Judge's discretion.

E/MAILED MOVE-UPS: When emailing a move-up, please just give the following information. TRIAL NAME, Owner Name, Dog Call Name, Move-up for what days (Saturday, Sunday, etc.), Moving from, Moving to (PLEASE include STD or JWW)

NOVICE MOVE-UPS: Dogs having attained their first AKC Agility Title (Std **OR** JWW) must be moved to the Nov B Class (Std **and** JWW) for all trials that have not reached the closing date. Once a trial closing date has past, a dog cannot be moved from Nov A to Nov B. If the trial has Move ups for Saturday/Sunday are due in writing by the **Monday at 6:00 p.m.** the week of the trial.

Before the trial: Move-ups may be made prior to the move-up deadline via e/mail to the Trial Secretary at shelteze@hotmail.com, by fax at 866-667-1054, or by regular mail to 6719 Old Grange Road, Slatington, PA 18080. Verbal move-up requests cannot be accepted.

Day-to-Day Move-Ups: are only allowed for dogs entered at the set of back-to-back agility trials for succeeding days of that set of back-to-back agility trials and must be submitted in writing at the trial within ½ hour of the last run of the trial day for the following day(s) and can not be conveyed via fax, email, or verbally to the trial secretary.

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

How do I know if I have a valid jump height card?

If your dog is under the age of two years as of the trial's date: One (1) temporary measurement is required. Once measured, be sure to retain the Agility Measurement Form yellow copy and check "My dog has a **Temporary** Jump Height Form" box, otherwise your dog needs to be measured. If your dog turns two years of age or is older as of the trial's date, your temporary measurement expires on their 2nd birthday and your dog needs to be measured.

If your dog is the age of two years or older as of the trial's date: A minimum of two (2) permanent measurements are required. If both permanent measurements place your dog into the same jump height class, the AKC office will issue you a permanent card. If not, then a third measurement is required to determine the dog's jump height class. Until such time that you have received all required measurements for a permanent jump height card, check the "My dog needs to be measured" box. Upon arrival at the trial, you must check to see if there is a Volunteer Measuring Official and/or an Agility Field Rep. present to perform official measurements. If not, and you possess a yellow copy of the Agility Measurement Form from a previous measurement, then your armband may be picked up during Check-In in lieu of being measured by the judge of record. Once you have received your permanent card from the AKC office, check the "My dog has a **Permanent** Jump Height Card" box on all future entry forms.

Exception to the 2 permanent measurement requirement: If your dog measures over 22 inches at the withers, you have the option of selecting the "Over 22" Request Perm" box at the top left corner of the Agility Measurement Form to receive a permanent jump height card from AKC after a single measurement. If you do so, please also sign below the checkbox. By doing so, you are giving up your right to have a 2nd measurement performed on your dog in the future; however, you are not giving up your right to have the challenge measurement process performed in the future. Once you have received your permanent card from the AKC office, check the "My dog has a **Permanent** Jump Height Card" box on all future entry forms.

What if my dog measures into a different jump height then what he is entered?

If your dog has been measured by an AKC Field Representative or Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) and is now eligible to jump in a lower height class, the measurement is effective immediately including any runs (regular or preferred class) which have not yet occurred on the same day that the measurement is recorded. This immediate action does not apply to measurements taken as part of completing the challenge measurement process. Dogs who measure into a higher jump height have always been required to be moved immediately.

May I challenge my dog's jump height card measurement?

Yes, each dog may go through the challenge process once after the age of two (2) years, if requested by the owner. (Any dogs under the age of two (2) years are also eligible for a challenge measurement.)

What is the jump height card challenge process?

The jump height card challenge process replicates the original measurement steps. A minimum of two (2) challenge measurements are required. If both challenge measurements place your dog into the same jump height class, then you will be issued a new permanent card from the AKC office. If the two challenge measurements place the dog in different jump height classes, then a third challenge measurement is required to determine the dog's jump height class.

Until such time that you have received all required challenge measurements, you must continue to compete at the original jump height stated on the permanent jump height card that is in your possession.

It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. *Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4.*

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. All height divisions will be offered in both the standard classes and the jumpers with weaves classes.

Regular exhibitors may choose to enter their dog in a higher height division than required by AKC, but not in a height division lower than the AKC mandated height.

Preferred exhibitors are required to jump in their proper height division.

**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS **

- **OPENING DATE 8:00 a.m. August 10, 2010** at 6719 Old Grange Road, Slatington, PA 18080. Trial is LIMITED to 660 runs per day. **CLOSING DATE** for entries 12:00 pm, **September 21, 2010**, after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules and in Chapter 1, Section 13 of the AKC Agility Trial Rules and Regulations.
- **ENTRY FEE** \$25.00 for the first entry of a dog; \$13.00 for each additional entry of the same dog per day. (Includes a \$3.00 AKC recording fee per run.) Envelopes/transactions cannot have entries for more than the (10) dogs maximum.
- **MAIL ALL ENTRIES WITH FEES PAYABLE TO WDTC, Joanne Stock, 6719 Old Grange Road, Slatington, PA 18080. Express mail deliveries must indicate "no signature required" for delivery.**
- **Entries not submitted on the current official AKC Entry forms (dated 01/10) or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules attached to the Official AKC Entry Form are not acceptable. Exhibitors are responsible for errors in making out entry forms.**
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- **REFUND POLICY:** Refunds will be given for bitches in season and for injured dogs. In order to be considered, requests must be received by the Trial Secretary, in writing, by the last day of the trial. All refund requests must be accompanied by a signed, dated letter on official business letterhead from your veterinarian stating the reason that your dog cannot compete, along with a copy of your trial confirmation letter. E-mails, telephone calls, and non-letterhead notes will not be considered.
- There will be a \$5.00 processing fee deducted per day from all refunded entry fees. This is per dog.
- Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid by the exhibitor will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. This includes the areas surrounding the outside of the show building.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.
- **JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS.** The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.
- Dogs participating must be fifteen months of age or older and must be registered with the American Kennel Club or have an AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Dogs must be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.
- Dogs may arrive any time prior to Judging.

If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
